


### Our Story

This annual brunch, held the first Saturday in December, supports the LGBTQ+ Student Success Fund. To date these events have raised over \$150,000! Some of the emergency situations include unplanned medical, transportation, equipment, housing, and tuition expenses that would jeopardize their college dreams.
